CHANGES PROPOSED TO INDIA'S LAW ON CHILD LABOUR

On July 1, 2015, the Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India, issued a notification¹ regarding the proposed changes to the Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1949.

The proposed changes are as follows:
